- Purpose:** The purpose of the workshop is to provide the participants with an overview of the current international standards and good practices relevant to long term operation of nuclear installations, refurbishment, life extension, specific regulatory review and inspections. More specifically, the workshop would: i) introduce the participants to the IAEA safety standards (requirements and guides) relevant for long term operation of nuclear installations, refurbishment and life extension; ii) IAEA standards and procedures within SALTO program; iii) improve the participants’ understanding of the concepts of long term operation and life extension; iv) provide the participants with an overview of the specific safety reviews and inspections that have to be performed by the operators to support the case for long term operation and/or life extension; v) provide lessons learned by the IAEA from SALTO missions held at other NPPs within LTO and ageing management activities; vi) explain what are the time limited ageing analyses and provide examples; vii) provide an overview of the specific safety reviews and inspections performed by the operator and the regulator during refurbishment of nuclear installations; and viii) give an overview of the specific safety reviews and inspections that have to be performed by the regulators to determine whether the licensees’ application for long term operation and/or life extension can be approved or not.

Expected Output(s):	It is expected that the participants to the workshop will use the information and knowledge acquired to improve their activities for performing and / or reviewing safety assessments and for performing inspections related to long term operation of nuclear installations, refurbishment and life extension.
Scope and Nature:	The scope of the workshop covers IAEA Safety Standards as well as best international practices in the area of Safe Long Term Operation of NPPs. The workshop will consist of lectures and practical exercises, as well as review of safety standards during operation of the South Ukraine NPP located in Yuzhnoukrainsk town.
Background Information:	The workshop has direct relations to the development of Ukraine's human resources qualified to perform nuclear safety reviews and inspections with the focus of country-specific Safe Long Term Operation programme.
Participation:	The workshop is open to 20 participants. Priority will be given to candidates from countries that are currently preparing nuclear installations for long term operation. Candidates from countries building nuclear power plants will be considered on need basis.
Participants' Qualifications:	The workshop participants should be professionals from the nuclear regulatory authority, as well as from the organizations operating NPPs and from Technical Support Organizations.
