Subject: Invitation to a Regional Workshop on self-assessment against the IAEA Safety Standard No. GSR Part 7 in EPRIMS for the European Region, Portoroz, Slovenia from 14 to 18 May 2018

Dear National Liaison Officer,

I am pleased to inform you that the International Atomic Energy Agency (IAEA) is organizing the above event under the IAEA Technical Cooperation project RER9137, "Enhancing National Capabilities for Response to Nuclear and Radiological Emergencies".

The purpose of the workshop is to: (i) familiarize and train participants on the IAEA Emergency Preparedness and Response Information System (EPRIMS); (ii) present EPRIMS benefits; (iii) give hands-on training on EPRIMS self-assessment against General Safety Requirements GSR Part 7; (iv) share national experiences on EPRIMS; and (v) discuss progress made good practice and challenges faced.


The attached Information Sheet and Logistical Arrangements provide further details, including technical and administrative aspects of the event. Selection of participants will be in accordance with IAEA procedures.

The IAEA will provide non-local participants with a round-trip air ticket based on the most direct and economical route between the airport nearest the participant's residence and Portoroz. Travel details will be agreed with the participants upon receipt of their official nomination. Participants will also receive an allowance from the IAEA sufficient to cover their costs of lodging, daily subsistence and miscellaneous expenses for the duration of the event in line with IAEA rules and procedures.
