Subject: Regional Training Course on the Clearance of Radioactive Waste from Regulatory Control, Bratislava, Slovakia from 25 September 2017 to 29 September 2017

Dear National Liaison Officer/National Coordinator,

I am pleased to inform you that the International Atomic Energy Agency (IAEA) is organizing the above event under the IAEA technical cooperation project RER9143, "Enhancing Radioactive Waste Management Capabilities".

Based on knowledge derived from the structured presentations and discussions participants will be encouraged to develop strategies for the characterisation and clearance of potentially suitable waste streams, as appropriate for national circumstances. In the longer term, it is expected that Member States will further develop and put into practice plans for radioactive and large volume free releasable waste management, including any initiated as a result of the training course. Consequently, the capacity and capability of Member States for managing and regulating radioactive waste, potentially suitable for clearance from regulatory control, will be enhanced.

The Information Sheet and Logistical Arrangements available on the IAEA's InTouch+ platform provide further details, including technical and administrative aspects of the course. Selection of participants will be in accordance with IAEA procedures.

The IAEA will provide non-local participants with a round-trip air ticket based on the most direct and economical route between the airport nearest the participant's residence and Bratislava. Travel details will be agreed with the participants upon receipt of their official nomination. Participants will also receive an allowance from the IAEA sufficient to cover their costs of lodging, daily subsistence and miscellaneous expenses for the duration of the course in line with IAEA rules and procedures.

Should this not be possible, applicants may download the Nomination Form for the course from the [IAEA's webpage](#). Please be advised that late nominations or replacements of participants after the closing date for nominations will not be accepted.
