



## PROSPECTUS

- Title:** **Regional Training Course on Security in the Transport of Radioactive Material**
- Place:** Karlsruhe, Germany
- Date:** 4–8 November 2013
- Deadline for nominations:** **15 September 2013**
- Organizers:** The International Atomic Energy Agency (IAEA) in cooperation with the Government of Germany through the Karlsruhe Institute of Technology (KIT)
- Language:** The language of instruction will be English.
- Participation:** The course is open to 42 participants from 41 IAEA Member States in Europe (one participant on average per invited country; a maximum of four nominations per invited country).  
The target audience for the course includes policymakers as well as representatives of law enforcement agencies, regulatory bodies, and operators.
- Target countries:** The course is organized for the following IAEA Member States:  
Albania, Austria, Belarus, Belgium, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Bulgaria, Czech Republic, Croatia, Denmark, Estonia, Finland, France, Germany (host country), Greece, Hungary, Iceland, Ireland, Italy, Latvia, Liechtenstein, Lithuania, Luxemburg, Malta, Monaco, Montenegro, Netherlands, Norway, Poland, Portugal, Republic of Moldova, Romania, Russian Federation, Serbia, Slovakia, Slovenia, Spain, Sweden, Switzerland, the former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia, Ukraine, and the United Kingdom.
- Purpose of the course:** The objective of this course is to create awareness of the need for security during the transport of radioactive material.  
  
It is expected that participants in the course will acquire up to date knowledge relevant to the development and implementation of national transport security requirements. They will also benefit from learning about specific security measures and technologies that may be used as part of a security system.
- Participants' qualifications and experience:** The nominated participants should be involved in the decision making process or in direct activities related to security in the transport of radioactive material in their respective countries.  
  
Participants should come primarily from Ministries of Transport, Ministries of the Interior, Ministries of Health or Ministries of Justice. Other targeted national institutions are regulatory bodies, customs offices, border guard services and any other State authorities that are involved in nuclear security issues.

Participants may also be drawn from operators involved in the transport of radioactive material.

Participants should be either senior officials or transport managers.

The course will be conducted in English; participants should therefore be capable of freely expressing themselves and following lectures in that language.

**Nature of the course:**

The course will consist of lectures and working sessions. During the working sessions, the participants will apply concepts introduced during the lectures.

The training programme will focus on, but not be restricted to:

- the recommendations provided in *Nuclear Security Recommendations on Radioactive Material and Associated Facilities* (IAEA Nuclear Security Series No. 14, Vienna, 2011); and
- the guidance provided in *Security in the Transport of Radioactive Material* (IAEA Nuclear Security Series No. 9, Vienna, 2008)
