I am pleased to inform you that the International Atomic Energy Agency (IAEA) is organizing the above event under the IAEA technical cooperation project RER5022, "Establishing Genetic Control Programmes for Aedes Invasive Mosquitoes".

The purpose of the event is to train the participants on the use of the toolkit on Social Communication for Sterile Insect Technique (SIT) mosquito project.

The attached Information Sheet provides further details, including technical and administrative aspects of the event. Selection of participants will be in accordance with IAEA procedures.

The IAEA will provide non-local participants with a round-trip air ticket based on the most direct and economical route between the airport nearest the participant's residence and Procida.
