I am pleased to invite you to send nominations of suitable candidates to participate in the Virtual Event - ESTRO Training Course on Image-Guided Radiotherapy in Clinical Practice within the framework of the IAEA technical cooperation project RER6036, "Improving Radiotherapy Practices for Advanced Radiotherapy Technologies Including Quality Assurance and Quality Control".

The purpose of the event is to support radiation oncologists, medical physicists and radiation therapists (RTTs), who are involved in target localisation at any point in the treatment chain.
