Purpose

The purpose of the virtual event is to assist the regulatory bodies in the region to establish and/or strengthen integrated regulatory bodies' management systems so that management and leadership foster and sustain a strong culture for radiation safety. Special attention will be given to the development of human resources planning.

Working Language

The working language of the event will be **English.**

Deadline for Nominations

Nominations received after 1 June 2021 will not be considered.

Project Background

The implementation of TC project RER9148 is aimed at strengthening the regulatory infrastructure for radiation safety. The TC project is implemented with the ultimate goal of protecting the people and the environment from potential adverse effects of ionizing radiation.

Scope and Nature

This virtual training course will include presentations, discussions and exercises. It will provide a forum to exchange information and share experience on how the IAEA requirements on the leadership and management for safety are reflected in the regulatory infrastructure for radiation safety and mostly in the Regulatory Bodies organisation and functions.

All participants are expected to participate in discussions and do preparatory work before attending the workshop.

A starting point for the counterparts will be the update of RASIMS Thematic Safety Area "Regulatory Infrastructure" (TSA-1).

Participation

The meeting is open to participants from each Member State participating in the TC project RER/9/148.

Participants' Qualifications and Experience

The nominated candidates should be senior regulators with experience in the leadership for safety and in the management for safety. Experience on the integrated management system of the Regulatory Body in the country is welcome.

Application Procedure

Candidates wishing to apply for this event should follow the steps below:

If the candidate is not a registered Nucleus user, she/he must create a Nucleus account (<u>https://websso.iaea.org/IM/UserRegistrationPage.aspx</u>) before proceeding with the event application process below.
- 2. On the InTouch + platform, the candidate must:
 - a. Finalize or update her/his personal details, provide sufficient information to establish the required qualifications regarding education, language skills and work experience ('Profile' tab) and upload relevant supporting documents;
 - b. Search for the relevant technical cooperation event (EVT2101691) under the 'My Eligible Events' tab, answer the mandatory questions and lastly submit the application to the required authority.

NOTE: Completed applications need to be approved by the relevant national authority, i.e. the **National Liaison Office**, and submitted to the IAEA through the established official channels by the provided designation deadline.
