I am pleased to inform you that the International Atomic Energy Agency (IAEA) is organizing the above event under the IAEA technical cooperation project RER5026, “Enhancing the Capacity to Integrate Sterile Insect Technique in the Effective Management of Invasive Aedes Mosquitoes”.

The purpose of the event is to: i) provide technical support for the participating Member States on mosquito surveillance and population monitoring, field baseline data collection and data management in SIT pilot trials; ii) explore a practical experience and skills using standardized field data spreadsheet, data management, and offer the participant the chance to analyse their own data with immediate support; iii) review current monitoring protocols and discuss relevant information in the form of presentations and learning materials provided by participants, the IAEA, and the experts and iv) strengthen and harmonize regional procedures and mechanisms for baseline data collection and data management in SIT pilot trials, including networking, and information exchange.
