Justification of practices and justification of non-medical imaging exposure



Realisation period: 21-25 September 2020; 19-23 April 2021

TASK

Preparing and holding a workshop on "Justification of practices and justification of non-medical imaging exposure" to further transpose and implement Articles 19, 20 (with Annex IV), 21, 22, 55 and 77 of the *Council Directive 2013/59/Euratom (BSS)* in bylaws and through established procedures.



RESULT

The transfer of knowledge through 2 days interactive conference on a theme: "Justification of practices and justification of non-medical imaging exposure" held on 21 – 22 April 2021 using Zoom.

On the first day talks were provided by representatives from the **EC, IAEA**, **ICRP** and **UNSCEAR**.

On the second day, talks were provided by representatives from professional organisations with representatives from the EFOMP, EFRS, ESTRO, COCIR, EANIM and ESR.

On both days **Guest countries** were invited to provide their views on justification. On the first day, presentations in the non-medical field were provided by Slovenia, Greece and Lithuania. On the second day, presentations in the medical field were provided by Serbia, Croatia, Slovenia, Greece and Lithuania.

CONCLUSIONS & RECOMMENDATIONS

- The existing regulations concerning the justification processes are in reasonably good alignment with the BSS Directive.
- The gap analysis should help to further develop the legislation.
