Dear National Liaison Officer / National Coordinator,

I am pleased to inform you that the International Atomic Energy Agency (IAEA) is organizing the above event under the IAEA technical cooperation project RER5026, “Enhancing the Capacity to Integrate Sterile Insect Technique in the Effective Management of Invasive Aedes Mosquitoes”.

The purpose of the training is to provide participants with the knowledge on data collection, management, and statistical analysis from mark release recapture (MRR) studies of Aedes mosquitoes in preparation of SIT pilot trials:
