## **Purpose**

The purpose of the event is to review and update the Member States' status on Radiation Protection to Control the Exposure of the Public, provide overview of the project background and objectives, discuss the issues and challenges, agree on the project workplan and activities.

#### **Project Background**

At the IAEA NSRW European regional workshop held in March 2019 in Cyprus, the participants presented challenges they faced during the implementation of the requirements of GSR Part 3. The issue of radiation protection of the public was among major challenges, particularly in areas of regulatory control of consumer products, non-medical human imaging and inspection devices, and commodities. Thus RER9159 was formulated to share the knowledge and information and to enhance their network and cooperation in this area.

- ii) review project background and objectives
- iii) discuss and agree on the workplan and activities including the venues

  - a. Finalize or update her/his personal details, provide sufficient information to establish the required qualifications regarding education, language skills and work experience ('Profile' tab) and upload relevant supporting documents;
  - b. Search for the relevant technical cooperation event (EVT2201582) under the 'My Eligible

Events' tab, answer the mandatory questions and lastly submit the application to the required authority.

**NOTE:** Completed applications need to be approved by the relevant national authority, i.e. the National Liaison Office, and submitted to the IAEA through the established official channels by the provided designation deadline.
